Copycat Zuppa Tuscana Soup

Ingredients

- 1 lb. ground pork sausage
- 3/4 cup onion diced
- 6 slices bacon diced
- 1 teaspoon garlic minced
- 4 cups chicken broth
- 1 cup potatoes cut into bite sized pieces
- 2 cups kale thinly sliced
- 3/4 cup whipping cream

- Instructions
 - 1. Cook sausage in a large skillet and brown over medium heat
 - 2. Drain and set aside
 - Place your onion and bacon in the skillet and sauté over medium heat until the onions are translucent
 - 4. Place sausage, onions, bacon and garlic in your large pot along with broth and potatoes
 - 5. Cook on low for 20 min
 - 6. Add kale and whipping cream and allow to simmer for 10 min before serving
